

Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your **FATHER** in heaven. [Matthew 5:16](#)

But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be children of your **FATHER** in heaven. [Matthew 5:16:44-45](#)

Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly **FATHER** is perfect. [Matthew 5:48](#)

“Be careful not to practice your righteousness in front of others to be seen by them. If you do, you will have no reward from your **FATHER** in heaven. “So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by others. But when you give to the needy...your giving [should] be in secret. Then your **FATHER**, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

“And when you pray...go into your room, close the door and pray to your **FATHER**, who is unseen. Then your **FATHER**, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you. And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. ...Your **FATHER** knows what you need before you ask him.

“This, then, is how you should pray: “Our **FATHER** in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly **FATHER** will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others their sins, your **FATHER** will not forgive your sins.

When you fast,...,[let it] not be obvious to others that you are fasting, but only to your **FATHER**, who is unseen; and your **FATHER**, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

The birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly **FATHER** feeds them. Are you not much more valuable? Can worrying add a single hour to your life? So do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ Your heavenly **FATHER** knows that you need them. Seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. [Matthew 6:1-4, 6-17, 17-18, 26-27, 31-32](#)

If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your **FATHER** in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him. [Matthew 7:11](#)

“Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my **FATHER** who is in heaven. [Matthew 7:21](#)

I am going to send you what my **FATHER** has promised.... [Luke 24:49](#)

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the **FATHER**, full of grace and truth. [John 1:14](#)

No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the **FATHER**, has made him known. [John 1:18](#)

To those who sold doves he said, “Get these out of here! Stop turning my **FATHER**’s house into a market!” [John 2:16](#)

The **FATHER** loves the Son and has placed everything in his hands. [John 3:35](#)

Jesus [said], “believe me, a time is coming when you will worship the **FATHER** neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem. [John 4:21](#)

Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the **FATHER** in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the **FATHER** seeks. [John 4:23](#)

In his defense Jesus said to them, “My **FATHER** is always at his work to this very day, and I too am working.” [John 5:17](#)

They tried all the more to kill him; ... he was even calling God his own **FATHER**, making himself equal with God. [John 5:18](#)

Jesus [said] “Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his **FATHER** doing, because whatever the **FATHER** does the Son also does. [John 5:19](#)

For the **FATHER** loves the Son and shows him all he does. Yes, and he will show him even greater works than these, so that you will be amazed. [John 5:20](#)

For just as the **FATHER** raises the dead and gives them life, even so the Son gives life to whom he is pleased to give it. [John 5:21](#)

Moreover, the **FATHER** judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son. [John 5:22](#)

All may honor the Son just as they honor the **FATHER**. Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the **FATHER**, who sent him. [John 5:23](#)

For as the **FATHER** has life in himself, so he has granted the Son to have life in himself. [John 5:26](#)

The works that the **FATHER** has given me to finish, the very works that I am doing, testify that the **FATHER** has sent me. [John 5:36](#)

And the **FATHER** who sent me has himself testified concerning me. You have never heard his voice nor seen his form. [John 5:37](#)

[Jesus said] I have come in my **FATHER**’s name, and you do not accept me. [John 5:43](#)

[Jesus said] Do not think I will accuse you before the **FATHER**. Your accuser is...on whom your hopes are set. [John 5:45](#)

Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For on him God the **FATHER** has placed his seal of approval. [John 6:27](#)

Jesus said to them, “Very truly I tell you, it is not Moses who has given you the bread from heaven, but it is my **FATHER** who gives you the true bread from heaven. [John 6:32](#)

All those the **FATHER** gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away. [John 6:37](#)

For my **FATHER**'s will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day.” [John 6:40](#)

“No one can come to me unless the **FATHER** who sent me draws them, and I will raise them up at the last day. [John 6:44](#)

It is written in the Prophets: ‘They will all be taught by God.’ Everyone who has heard the **FATHER** and learned from him comes to me. [John 6:45](#)

No one has seen the **FATHER** except the one who is from God; only he has seen the **FATHER**. [John 6:46](#)

Just as the living **FATHER** sent me and I live because of the **FATHER**, so the one who feeds on me will live because of me.

[John 6:57](#)

He went on to say, “This is why I told you that no one can come to me unless the **FATHER** has enabled them.” [John 6:65](#)

But if I do judge, my decisions are true, because I am not alone. I stand with the **FATHER**, who sent me. [John 8:16](#)

I am one who testifies for myself; my other witness is the **FATHER**, who sent me. [John 8:18](#)

Then they asked him, “Where is your **FATHER**?” “You do not know me or my **FATHER**,” Jesus replied. “If you knew me, you would know my **FATHER** also.” [John 8:19](#)

They did not understand that he was telling them about his **FATHER**. [John 8:27](#)

Jesus said, “When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he and that I do nothing on my own but speak just what the **FATHER** has taught me. [John 8:28](#)

I am telling you what I have seen in the **FATHER**'s presence, and you are doing what you have heard from your father. [John 8:38](#)

The only **FATHER** we have is God himself. [John 8:41](#)

Jesus said.., “If God were your **FATHER**, you would love me, for I have come here from God. I have not come on my own; God sent me. [John 8:42](#)

“I am not possessed by a demon,” said Jesus, “but I honor my **FATHER** and you dishonor me. [John 8:49](#)

Jesus [said], "If I glorify myself, my glory means nothing. My **FATHER**, whom you claim as your God, is the one who glorifies me. Just as the **FATHER** knows me and I know the **FATHER**....The reason my **FATHER** loves me is that I lay down my life.... No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and...take it up again. This...I received from my **FATHER**." [John 8:54; 10:15, 17-18](#)

Jesus answered, "I did tell you, but you do not believe. The works I do in my **FATHER**'s name testify about me, [John 10:25](#)

My **FATHER**, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my **FATHER**'s hand. [John 10:29](#)

Jesus said "I and the **FATHER** are one.... I have shown you many good works from the **FATHER**.... What about the one whom the **FATHER** set apart as his very own and sent into the world? Why then do you accuse me of blasphemy because I said, 'I am God's Son'? Do not believe me unless I do the works of my **FATHER**. But if I do them, even though you do not believe me, believe the works, that you may know and understand that the **FATHER** is in me, and I in the **FATHER**." [John 10:30, 32, 36-38](#)

So they took away the stone. Then Jesus looked up and said, "**FATHER**, I thank you that you have heard me. [John 11:41](#)

Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, my servant also will be. My **FATHER** will honor the one who serves me. [John 12:26](#)

"Now my soul is troubled, and what shall I say? '**FATHER**, save me from this hour'? No, it was for this very reason I came to this hour. [John 12:27](#)

**FATHER**, glorify your name!" Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it, and will glorify it again." [John 12:28](#)

For I did not speak on my own, but the **FATHER** who sent me commanded me to say all that I have spoken. [John 12:49](#)

I know that His command leads to eternal life. So whatever I say is just what the **FATHER** has told me to say. [John 12:50](#)

It was just before the Passover Festival. Jesus knew that the hour had come for him to leave this world and go to the **FATHER**. Having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end. [John 13:1](#)

Jesus knew that the **FATHER** had put all things under his power, and that he had come from God and was returning to God; [John 13:3](#)

My **FATHER**'s house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? [John 14:2](#)

Jesus [said], "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the **FATHER** except through me. [John 14:6](#)

[Jesus said] If you really know me, you will know my **FATHER** as well. From now on, you do know him and have seen him.” Philip said, “Lord, show us the **FATHER** and that will be enough for us.”

Jesus answered: “Don’t you know me, Philip, even after I have been among you such a long time? Anyone who has seen me has seen the **FATHER**. How can you say, ‘Show us the **FATHER**’? Don’t you believe that I am in the **FATHER**, and that the **FATHER** is in me? The words I say to you I do not speak on my own authority. Rather, it is the **FATHER**, living in me, who is doing his work.

I am in the **FATHER** and the **FATHER** is in me; believe on the evidence of the works themselves. Whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the **FATHER**. And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the **FATHER** may be glorified in the Son. And I will ask the **FATHER**, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever. [John 14:7-13, 16](#)

[Jesus said] ... “I am in my **FATHER**, and you are in me, and I am in you. Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my **FATHER**, and I too will love them and show myself to them.”

Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My **FATHER** will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. Anyone who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the **FATHER** who sent me. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the **FATHER** will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

You heard me say, ‘I am going away and I am coming back to you.’ If you loved me, you would be glad that I am going to the **FATHER**, for the **FATHER** is greater than I.

The prince of this world is coming. He has no hold over me, but he comes so that the world may learn that I love the **FATHER** and do exactly what my **FATHER** has commanded me. [John 14:20-21, 23-24, 26, 28 30-31](#)

“I am the true vine, and my **FATHER** is the gardener. This is to my **FATHER**’s glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples. As the **FATHER** has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my **FATHER**’s commands and remain in his love. [John 15:1, 8-10](#)

I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master’s business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my **FATHER** I have made known to YOU. [John 15:15](#)

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the **FATHER** will give you. [John 15:16](#)

Whoever hates me hates my **FATHER** as well. [John 15:23](#)

If I had not done among them the works no one else did, they would not be guilty of sin. As it is, they have seen, and yet they have hated both me and my **FATHER**. [John 15:24](#)

When the [*Holy Spirit*] comes, whom I will send to you from the **FATHER**—the Spirit of truth who goes out from the **FATHER**—he will testify about me. [John 15:26](#)

[Jesus said the time is coming when anyone who kills you will think they are offering a service to God. They will do such things because they have not known the Father or me. But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate [*Holy Spirit*] will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. When he comes, he will prove the world to be in the wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment: about sin, because people do not believe in me; about righteousness, because I am going to the **FATHER**, where you can see me no longer; and about judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned.

But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. He will glorify me because it is from me that he will receive what he will make known to you. All that belongs to the **FATHER** is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will receive from me what he will make known to you. In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me.”

At this, some of his disciples said to one another, “What does he mean by saying, ... ‘Because I am going to the **FATHER**?’” They kept asking, “What does he mean by ‘a little while’?”

Jesus saw that they wanted to ask him about this, so he said to them, In that day you will no longer ask me anything. Very truly I tell you, my **FATHER** will give you whatever you ask in my name. A time is coming when I... will tell you plainly about my **FATHER**. In that day you will ask in my name. I am not saying that I will ask the **FATHER** on your behalf. No, the **FATHER** himself loves you because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God. I came from the **FATHER** and entered the world; now I am leaving the world and going back to the **FATHER**.”

“Do you now believe?” Jesus replied. “I am not alone, for my **FATHER** is with me. I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.” [John 16:2-3, 7-11, 13-19,23, 25-28, 31-33](#)

After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed: “**FATHER**, the hour has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you. And now, **FATHER**, glorify me in your presence with the glory I had with you before the world began. [John 17:1, 5](#)

I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy **FATHER**, protect them by the power of your name, the name you gave me, so that they may be one as we are one. [John 17:11](#)

“My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, **FATHER**, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me. I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one. [John 17:20-22](#)

“**FATHER**, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world. [John 17:24](#)

“Righteous **FATHER**, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have sent me. [John 17:25](#)

Jesus said, “Peace be with you! As the **FATHER** has sent me, I send you.” [John 20:21](#)

Jesus commanded Peter, “Put your sword away! Shall I not drink the cup the **FATHER** has given me?” [John 18:11](#)

Jesus said, “Do not hold on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the **FATHER**. Go instead to my brothers and tell them, ‘I am ascending to my **FATHER** and your **FATHER**, to my God and your God.’” [John 20:17](#)

While he was eating with them, [Jesus] gave them this command: “Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my **FATHER** promised, which you have heard me speak about. [Acts 1:4](#)

He said to them: “It is not for you to know the times or dates the **FATHER** has set by his own authority. [Acts 1:7](#)

Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the **FATHER** the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear. [Acts 2:33](#)

Don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the **FATHER**, we too may live a new life. For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his. [Romans 6:3-5](#)

The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, “*Abba, FATHER.*” [Romans 8:15](#)

May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had, so that with one mind and one voice you may glorify the God and **FATHER** of our Lord Jesus Christ. [Romans 15:5-7](#)

Grace and peace to you from God our **FATHER** and the Lord Jesus Christ. [1 Corinthians 1:3](#); [1 Corinthians 1:2](#); [Galatians 1:3](#); [Romans 1:7](#); [Ephesians 1:2](#); [Philippians 1:2](#); [Titus 1:4](#); [Philemon 1:3](#); [2 Thessalonians 1:2](#)
